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What Parents Should Teach Their Children About Money
Proverbs 1:7, 8

Proverbs 22:6 reads, *“Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.”* (KJV) This verse reveals that one task parents have is to help their sons and daughters travel in the right direction. Fathers and mothers can accomplish this goal by addressing topics that are vital to their children’s success in life. One key area that everyone should teach about is finances. This lesson is design to share practical ways parents can expose, educate and empower their children on the subject of money.

1. Parents should teach their children how to **Prioritize** money.
Proverbs 3:9, 10
“Honor the LORD by giving him your money and the first part of all your crops. 10) Then you will have more grain and grapes than you will ever need.” (CEV)
2. Parents should teach their children how to **Realize** money.
Proverbs 21:5
“Good planning and hard work lead to prosperity, but hasty shortcuts lead to poverty.” (NLT)
3. Parents should teach their children how to **Stabilize** money.
Proverbs 21:20
“The wise man saves for the future, but the foolish man spends whatever he gets.” (LB)
4. Parents should teach their children how to **Utilize** money.
Proverbs 29:3
“The man who loves wisdom brings joy to his father, but if he hangs around with prostitutes, his wealth is wasted.” (NLT)

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
